

## Care and Cleaning Information for Wall Panels

## Care and Cleaning

- Dust Removal: Regular dusting with a soft duster/cloth or a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment is generally sufficient.
- Stain Removal: For stubborn stains, always test the cleaning method on a less visible area first. Usually, a mild cleaning agent and a damp cloth will suffice.
- Avoid Aggressive Cleaners: Avoid using harsh cleaning agents, abrasives, or solvents as these can damage the material.
- Caution with Moisture: Excessive moisture can promote mold growth and damage the material.
- Mechanical Stress: Avoid strong mechanical stress as this can damage the surface.
- Location: Choose the location of the acoustic panels so that they are not directly exposed to sunlight or moisture.
- Ventilation: Ensure regular ventilation of the application area.
